# Article 04 Add to Land & Building Fund

Commissioner Pyra replied that the fund cannot support it. Discussion ensued regarding the money that needs to be set aside for the Water District. Being no further discussion, vote was taken. Motion failed.

#### Article 5 Fire Prevention ETF

Commissioner Pyra made a motion to recommend Article 5, Fire Prevention ETF. Charlie seconded the motion. Kevin asked how they can recommend something without knowing the final number. Discussion ensued regarding when the final numbers will be available and when the articles need the be to DRA for approval. Being no further discussion, vote was taken. Motion passed.

## Article 6 Fire Prevention Budget

Kevin asked why they didn't include fuel in the amendment. Chief Sitar replied that it would be more than the additional income they are making. Being no further discussion, vote was taken. Motion passed.

#### Article 12 Operating Budget
